# Programme

## Timed activities

**6.30-6.50pm** and **7.00-7.20pm** - Meet the curators: find some of the team behind *Beyond the Binary* in the exhibition space (*Ground Floor, exhibition space*)

**6.30pm** - Drag Queen Story Corner: Asifa Lahore, Britain's first out Muslim drag queen, has recorded a selection of stories celebrating diverse families specially for *Beyond the Binary* and Sassy Zine (*Old Library, Ground Floor*)

**6.45pm** and **7.30pm** - Object talk: meet community partner, Beth Asbury, and discover the unexpected link between the museum's founder, General Pitt-Rivers, and queer history (*Top Floor, far left corner of the gallery*)

## Drop-in stalls and workshops

**Object Handling** – encounter newly commissioned objects representing some LGBTQIA+ lived experiences and other objects about identity (*Ground Floor*)
